


Use a dictionary to look up the meaning of each. Can you make up a sentence of your own using the words?</p>
<p><b>PE</b> Create a 16 count motif to a favourite piece of music. Can you repeat it using different levels? Try to perform it confidently to someone in your family.</p>	<p><b>Enquiry</b> Create a guide to explain how to grow a plant. You might want to share this as a video, piece of writing or labelled pictures.</p>	<p><b>Wellbeing</b> Can you do 10,000 steps (or more) in one day? How do you feel?</p>
<p><b>DT</b> Use paper and cardboard to make the strongest bridge. Can you make improvements to make it even stronger?</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b> What is your Dream Job? Name 3 steps that you will need to do to reach your goal.</p>	<p><b>Writing</b> Create a story of your own using our new book character (to be revealed). What mischief could they cause?</p>
