


Our aim is for all children to be able to tell the o' clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to times.</p>	<p>Spelling Make a wordsearch with your spelling words. You might like to try some words which end in the different ways to write /l/.</p>
<p>PE Create a target ball game and play with someone else in your family. How can you make sure that the ball lands as near to the target as possible?</p>	<p>Enquiry Create a guide to explain how to look after an animal. You might want to share this as a video, piece of writing or labelled pictures.</p>	<p>Music Listen to different types of music. Which is your favourite and why? You might like to respond to the dynamics (loudness or softness) by using your body to go low or high.</p>
