We often find that the transition from Numbots to TTRS in Year 2 can sometimes cause problems at home, as TTRS introduces the element of times tables facts having a time limit. Using Hit the Button, which can be untimed, can help by being a great transitional website, before committing to TTRS more regularly. Also a great game for keeping regularly needed skills, such as number bonds fresh.

[Multiplication Tables Check - Mathsframe](#)

We recommend this website for any parents of children in Year 4, who all sit the statutory multiplication tables check in June each year. This is the closest replica site to the test that they sit, so is great to build confidence. We recommend not fiddling with the settings, the questions asked should be 25, and the time limit should be 6 seconds, to mirror the government check.
